

OAKLAWN RACING CLUB, INC.

Perks of Membership:

- Two free reserved seats on days the Club horse runs at Oaklawn. Excludes Rebel Stakes Day and Arkansas Derby Day.
- Barn Area Tours and Club Events (as planned by the Club manager and approved by Oaklawn)
- Thrill of victory! (We hope!)

Q: How many memberships will be sold in the Club?

A: Initially, up to 200 memberships will be sold in the Club for \$500 each on a first come, first served basis. Starting with the 2018 live racing season, memberships may be sold on a year-round basis.

Q: What is my \$500 for?

A: The funds raised from selling memberships will be used to pay the purchase price for the horse, as well as for training fees and other expenses of the Club horse for one full year.

Q: How much money will I be able to make off of my membership through this Club?

A: The Club is organized as a not-for-profit, educational association, and you should not join the Club with any profit motive or expectation of profit. Understand that there are risks involved in horse racing and you may not receive back any of your \$500 membership fee; and you acknowledge and agree that the maximum you may receive back is \$500. Any amount remaining above the initial investment, if any, will be contributed to a Thoroughbred racing related charity as determined by the Board of Directors of the Club.

Q: What do I have to do to become a member of the Oaklawn Racing Club?

A: Click on the "Buy Membership Here" button on the main Oaklawn Racing Club webpage and you will be directed to etix.com where you can purchase a membership. Then, all you have to do is sit back, relax and have fun! Oaklawn Racing Club will keep you up to date with all of the happenings of the Oaklawn Racing Club horse, so you can be part of the horse's journey.

Q: Is there an age limit for participants?

A: All members must be at least 18-years-old to participate.

Q: Once I become part of the Club, how will I receive information about the horse and Club news?

A: You will receive communications from Jennifer Hoyt, the Club manager, through e-mail and social media. The Club manager will receive information regarding the training, health, performance, etc. of the horse from the trainer.

Q: What are the perks of membership in the Oaklawn Racing Club?

A: All members will receive two free Grandstand seats in the horsemen section on days the Club horse runs at Oaklawn (excluding Rebel Stakes and Arkansas Derby Day). In addition, there will be no door

charges in the Carousel or Post Parade Restaurants for each member and one guest. This also excludes Rebel and Arkansas Derby Days. Use of the Carousel and Post Parade Restaurants are subject to availability.

Q: As a member of the Oaklawn Racing Club, do I also get membership in the Oaklawn Club?

A: No, the two are completely separate. If interested, you would also need to become a member of the Oaklawn Club to reserve your seats in this area on race days.

Q: Will I be able to see the Club's horse on days the horse races at Oaklawn?

A: Yes, a special VIP Paddock Zone has been created for the 2018 season where Oaklawn Racing Club members will be able to see and take photos of the Club's horse prior to the race. In order to ensure the highest level of safety for all Club members and the horses, the VIP Paddock Zone will be situated just outside of the Paddock railing.

Q: What Club Events will be held?

A: Special Oaklawn Racing Club social events will be held at Oaklawn each month throughout the racing season (Jan. 12 – April 14, 2018). Members will be notified about all event details closer to the event dates.

Q: Who will train the Oaklawn Racing Club horse?

A: Ron Moquett is the initial trainer selected by the Club. The Board of Directors of the Club has the right to designate a successor trainer.

Q: When will the horse race?

A: The trainer has already begun his search and the Club expects that the horse will be purchased as early as September 2017. The Club will initially purchase one horse with the intention of racing at Oaklawn during the 2018 season and then the expectation is that horse will likely move to the Kentucky circuit.

Q: Who will make decisions about the horse and manage communication and funds?

A: The horse trainer will make all decisions about the horse in consultation with the Club manager. Jennifer Hoyt (or such other person appointed by the Board of Directors of the Club) will represent the Club's interest as the Club Manager of the horse. Ultimate decision-making authority rests with the Board of Directors of the Club.

Q: What happens at the end of the 2018 Oaklawn season?

A: If there are enough funds remaining in the Club account when the Oaklawn meet ends and if, in the opinion of the trainer, the horse is healthy and fit to continue racing, it is expected that the horse will race at other tracks until Aug. 8, 2018. At this time, members will have the option of purchasing another membership for the next racing year that may or may not include the original club horse.

If it becomes prudent to cease operations at an earlier date, as determined by the Board of Directors of the Club after consultation with the trainer and Club manager, the horse will be sold and any monies remaining in the account after all financial obligations are met will be returned to the members pro rata up to \$500 per member (without interest). If there are any funds remaining after all membership fees have been returned, the remaining funds will be contributed to one or more Thoroughbred racing related charities as determined by the Board of Directors of the Club.
